Request for Proposals (RFP) for Engineering and Design Services for 8th Street South Reconstruction.

Description:

Authorizing the release of a Request for Proposals for engineering and design services for the 8th Street South Reconstruction.

Previous Actions:

November 14, 2014 – City Council authorized the submittal of a series of funding applications to the Metropolitan Council Regional Solicitation for Federal Transportation Funds, including the 8th Street South Reconstruction Project.

Background/Analysis:

The reconstruction of 8th Street South in downtown from Hennepin Avenue to Chicago Avenue is currently funded in the City's Five-Year Capital Improvement Program. This project requires the services of a qualified consulting firm or team of firms for Engineering and Design Services for the reconstruction of 8th Street South from Hennepin Avenue to Chicago Avenue. Specific major tasks will include preliminary and final design, public involvement, preparation of bid documents, and construction administration as an optional task.

The intent of the project is to fully reconstruct 8th Street South with a new roadway surface, curb and gutter, sidewalks, traffic signals, lighting, and landscaping. This project will be developed in coordination with Metro Transit and will include transit stations for the Arterial Bus Rapid Transit system.

The overall value of the contract from this RFP is expected to be approximately \$1 million. This project was awarded Federal Funding through the Metropolitan Council's Regional Solicitation process earlier this year. The project was awarded \$6,960,600 in the 2019 program year. The total cost for the project is estimated at approximately \$10.4 Million.
