Contract with the University Of Minnesota College Of Continuing Education to deliver supervisory training for City of Minneapolis employees

Description:

Authorizing a contract with the University Of Minnesota College Of Continuing Education, using the University's Workshop/Presentation Agreement as amended by the City of Minneapolis, and approving the expenditure not-to-exceed \$50,000 for up to 10 days of supervisory training for the period ending Dec. 31, 2017.

Background/Analysis:

In 2015, Human Resources announced the launch of SupervisorU, a series of supervisory training workshops. After interviewing 9 training and development vendors and reviewing proposals from three, Human Resources selected the University of Minnesota, College of Continuing Education (CCE) as best suited to deliver several of the SupervisorU workshops. College of Continuing Education demonstrated that it could provide qualified instructors, able to deliver proven content that integrated well with other training offered by the City. In addition College of Continuing Education offered a capable "bench" of qualified, experienced instructors.
