**W&M** - Your Committee recommends that the Police Department be authorized to submit a grant application to the Bureau of Justice Assistance seeking up to \$600,000 in funding, including a required matching component of up to the grant award, to provide funds to develop, implement, and evaluate a comprehensive program for body-worn cameras by selected Police Department personnel, with input from the community and criminal justice system, to improve law enforcement and to enhance officer interaction with the public; further, due to the grant submission deadline of June 16, 2015, to report on the desirability of submitting the application on behalf of the City to the Public Safety, Civil Rights & Emergency Management Committee at its next regular meeting on June 10, 2015; and further to empower the Public Safety, Civil Rights & Emergency Management Committee to determine the advisability of proceeding with the grant application submission, subject to ratification by the full City Council.
