Contract with CornerHouse for Forensic Interview Services

Description:

Approving amendment with CornerHouse Interagency Child Abuse Evaluation and Training Center for conducting forensic interviews of children and vulnerable adults. The one-year contract extension for \$156,373 is budgeted in the Police Department 2016 budget.

Previous Actions:

CornerHouse has provided forensic interview services since its founding in 1989.

Background/Analysis:

The Police Department currently contracts with CornerHouse Interagency Child Abuse Evaluation and Training Center for forensic interview services of children and vulnerable adults. Following an RFP in 2011, this contract was entered into in 2012 for three years, with the option for two one-year extensions. The Police Department wishes to exercise the option to extend the current contract for a second year and has negotiated a new annual contract cost of \$156,373 for 2016 (an increase of 2%). This is a budgeted expense in the Police Budget.
