License agreement with Minneapolis Public Schools for use of space in a public health emergency.

Description:

Authorizing the proper City officials to enter into a ten year license agreement with Minneapolis Public Schools, Special School District #1 to use space in multiple school sites for providing services to the general public for public health emergencies.

February 25, 2011 approval of a five year license agreement.

Background/Analysis:

The department is requesting to enter into a ten year lease agreement with Minneapolis Public Schools (MPS) for use of school space for services to the public in the event of a public health emergency. The prior five year agreement expired on December 31, 2015. The City has a similar ten year agreement with MPS for use of space for the School Based Clinic program through 2018.
