Revenue contract with the University of Minnesota for bomb detection at the TCF Stadium for fourteen (14) large scale events

Description:

Authorize a revenue agreement for up to \$102,500 with the University of Minnesota for the City of Minneapolis Police department to provide up to four (4) Bomb Unit technicians and up to four (4) Police Officer K-9 handlers, for bomb detection security services at TCF Stadium for up to fourteen (14) large scale events during 2016.

Previous Actions:

The Minneapolis Police department has been providing bomb detection security services for the TCF Stadium since 2014.

The Police Department will provide up to four (4) Bomb Unit technicians and up to four (4) Police Officer K-9 handlers, compensated at \$96 per hour per officer for up to nine and a half (9.5) hours per event totaling up to \$102,500
