

Dear Mr. Schlueter,

This letter is to provide the justification for accepting the sole bid from PCIRoads, LLC, for the mill and low slump overlay for the 49th Ave N and Queen Ave N Bridge Project.

In regards to low slump overlays, there are not very many private contractors that perform this type of work. There are only two that work in Minnesota. One of them offered the sole bid, and the other indicated that the City's project was of a smaller scale and that they were not interested in bidding.

Last year, in 2015, the City bid a low slump overlay project on the 11th Ave S Bridge. The bid prices are comparable between these two projects.

I would recommend that the City accept the sole bid received from PCIRoads, LLC, in the amount of \$105,225.00.
