Description:

1. Authorizing grant agreement with the Mississippi Watershed Management Organization accepting \$19,200 to hire interns to assist in erosion control enforcement in 2016.
2. Passage of Resolution appropriating the funds to the Health Department.

Background/Analysis:

The Mississippi Watershed Management Organization (MWMO) works with the City to address water quality issues in Minneapolis. The MWMO will continue in 2016 to pay for intern positions with Environmental Services to assist in erosion control enforcement. In addition, the interns will work cooperatively with both organizations in conducting studies in best management practices for storm water management, water sampling, and other projects related to storm water quality in Minneapolis

Financial Review:

Additional appropriation required.

Action requires an appropriation increase to the Operating Budget by \$19,200. Action provides increased revenue for increase of \$19,200.
