Revenue agreement with the Downtown Improvement District for police officer assistance for the 2016 Minneapolis Downtown Improvement District Summer Police and Police Reserve Program

**Description:**

Authorize a revenue agreement with the Downtown Improvement District for the Minneapolis Police Department to receive up to \$30,000 in buy-back funds for increased policing in downtown Minneapolis where crime mapping and safety perception has indicated a need for extra police presence from May 1, 2016 – August 27, 2016.

**Previous Actions:**

The Downtown Improvement District contracts separately with Police Reserves for additional patrolling in the downtown Minneapolis area.  
Council previously approved two (2) revenue agreements with the Downtown Improvement District to receive funds for police officer assistance for the 2014 and 2015 Downtown Summer Community Engagement Program on 06/27/14 (file# not found, Resolution 2014R-281) and 10/09/15 (15-00483) respectively

**Background/Analysis:**

City of Minneapolis Police to be reimbursed via buy-back by the Downtown Improvement District for law enforcement services in support of the 2016 MPD/MDID Summer Police and Reserve Program at the rate of the working officer's actual salary rate x 1.5 plus 18.75% for variable fringes with a maximum of \$30,000.
