Background/Analysis:

The MPD participates in Joint Law Enforcement Operations including work with the United States Marshals Service in joint operations investigating fugitives, to improve public safety, reduce violent crime and reduce the number of non-compliant sex offenders. As a participant the Minneapolis Police Department is eligible to receive a vehicle that becomes part of the MPD fleet. The United States Marshals Service does not assume any ownership of the vehicle and the MPD assumes responsibility for maintenance, fuel, other as needed.
