

REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL FROM
THE PUBLIC SAFETY, CIVIL RIGHTS & EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE
STANDING COMMITTEE OF THE MINNEAPOLIS CITY COUNCIL
March 23, 2016

A regular meeting of the committee was convened at 1:34 p.m. on this date.

Members Present: Council Members Blong Yang (Chair), Cam Gordon, Barbara Johnson, John Quincy and Linea Palmisano (Quorum 4)

Matters listed below are hereby submitted with the following recommendations; to-wit:

1. Contract with the University of Minnesota for Minneapolis Police SWAT Officers to provide extra security at TCF Stadium for up to 14 large scale events in 2016 ([16-00392](#))
 1. Authorizing a revenue agreement for up to \$102,500 with the University of Minnesota for the City of Minneapolis Police Department to provide up to eight SWAT officers for extra security and a tactical response at TCF Stadium for up to 14 large scale events that include sporting events and concerts from February 2016 through December 2016.
 2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Police Department (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

2. Contract with the University of Minnesota for Minneapolis Police SWAT Officers to provide extra security at TCF Stadium during two 2015 Gopher football games and four 2015 Vikings football games ([16-00393](#))
 1. Authorizing a revenue agreement for up to \$55,000 with the University of Minnesota for the City of Minneapolis Police Department to provide up to eight SWAT officers for extra security and a tactical response at TCF Stadium during two Gopher football games and four Vikings football games during the 2015 football season.
 2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Police Department (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

3. Contract with the Downtown Improvement District (DID) for police officer assistance for the 2016 Minneapolis DID Summer Police and Police Reserve Program ([16-00394](#))

Authorizing a revenue agreement with the Downtown Improvement District for the Minneapolis Police Department to receive up to \$30,000 in buy-back funds for increased policing in downtown Minneapolis where crime mapping and safety perception has indicated a need for extra police presence from May 1, 2016 – August 27, 2016 (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

4. Contract with Hennepin Technical College for cadet-recruit training in Spring 2016 ([16-00395](#))

Authorizing a contract with Hennepin Technical College (HTC) in an amount not to exceed \$149,326, for training services for cadet/recruit training to be conducted in the Spring of 2016 for up to 32 pre-selected Police cadet/recruit candidates (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

5. Contract amendment with University of Minnesota for extra security services during NHL Stadium Series Alumni Game at TCF Stadium ([16-00396](#))

1. Authorizing an increase to revenue contract C-40393 with the University of Minnesota by \$4,000, for a new not to exceed amount of \$20,000, and extending to Feb. 22, 2016, for the City of Minneapolis Police department to provide extra security services during the NHL Stadium Series Alumni Game at the TCF Stadium on Feb. 20, 2016.

2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Police Department (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

6. Contract amendment with the University of Minnesota for bomb detection at TCF Stadium ([16-00397](#))

1. Authorizing an increase to revenue contract C-40230 with the University of Minnesota by \$4,785, for a new not to exceed amount of \$31,000.

2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Police Department (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

7. Contract amendment with CornerHouse Interagency Child Abuse Evaluation and Training Center for forensic interview services ([16-00398](#))

Approving a correction to contract amendment with CornerHouse Interagency Child Abuse Evaluation and Training Center for conducting forensic interviews of children and vulnerable adults, changing amount from \$156,373 to \$158,719, for a new contract total of \$756,786 (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

8. Grant acceptance from the United States Marshals Service of a vehicle ([16-00399](#))

Accepting a vehicle provided by the U.S. Marshals Service for participants in Joint Law Enforcement Operations for use by the Predator Offender Registration Program (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

9. Request For Proposals (RFP) issuance for consultants/events planners for 2018 Super Bowl ([16-00400](#))

Authorizing issuance of a Request for Proposals (RFP) to contract for two consultants/event planners for the 2018 Super Bowl (**Refer to WM**).

On motion by Yang, carried on voice vote, the matter was approved and referred to the Ways & Means Committee.

10. Office of Police Conduct Review (OPCR) Annual Report ([16-00401](#))

Receiving the Office of Police Conduct Review (OPCR) 2015 Annual Report.

Staff presentation by Imani Jaafar and Ryan Patrick, Department of Civil Rights/Office of Police Conduct Review; Jason Case, Police Department/Commander of Internal Affairs; and Jennifer Singleton, Vice Chair of the Police Conduct Oversight Commission.
