VERTICAL CUE

Vertical Cue is a Midtown Greenway visual access beacon. Vertical Cues are tall, slim, Midtown Greenway branded green metal structures. At more significant access points (i.e. at bike route intersections) the Vertical Cue may be expressed as a gateway structure.

Rule: Vertical Cue is located at the access to the Midtown Greenway. This element is used at the top of the access points along the trench, or at on-grade access points where visual connectivity is helpful for navigation to the trail.
