Legal Settlement - Workers' compensation claim of Gary L. Peterson v. City of Minneapolis

Description:

Approving the settlement of this Workers' compensation claim Gary L. Peterson v. City of Minneapolis by payment of \$315,000 to Gary L. Peterson and his attorney, Gerald W. Bosch, and authorizing the City Attorney's Office to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the settlement.

Background/Analysis:

This claim arises out of multiple work related injuries suffered by Gary L. Peterson while he was a police officer with the Minneapolis Police Department from April 8, 1968 to October 14, 1988. As a consequence of his work-related injuries and corresponding permanent physical restrictions, Mr. Peterson is entitled to a number of benefits through workers' compensation.

Any settlement in excess of \$75,000 must be approved by the Council. Following negotiations and mediation with his attorney, we have reached a tentative settlement of Mr. Peterson's workers' compensation claim on a full, final and complete basis in the amount of \$315,000.00. This proposed settlement has been discussed with the Police Department and it is in agreement with the terms. We believe that the settlement is in the best interests of the City and recommend approval by this Committee.
