Description:

1. Accepting \$1,296,549 grant from the Minnesota Department of Health for family home visiting services over five years.

Background/Analysis:

The department has received a five year award from the state to continue the expansion of Nurse Family Partnership evidence-based home visiting to at-risk populations in Minneapolis. These populations represent culturally diverse communities (predominantly black and Latino), who have a primary or secondary experience with child abuse or neglect, domestic violence and have low educational achievement. Evidence based home visiting has been demonstrated to be effective in intervening in families at risk to improve family health outcomes.
