**Subject:**

Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension Joint Powers Agreement for the Criminal Justice Data Communications Network (CJDN) and Court Data Services Subscriber Amendment to the CJDN agreement.

**Description:**

1. Authorizing entering into the five-year State of Minnesota Joint Powers Agreement for the Criminal Justice Data Communications Network (CJDN) Agreement for sharing criminal justice information among criminal justice agencies.
2. Authorizing entering into the Court Data Services Subscriber Amendment to the CJDN Joint Powers Agreement for court-related criminal justice information.
3. Approving quarterly payments of \$21,450 to the State Bureau of Apprehension to access to the Criminal Justice Data Communications Network (CJDN) with the annual contract total of \$85,800 and \$429,000 over the five year term of the agreement.
