Hi Ashley,

The reasons that we should proceed with this single bid are:

1. There are only three companies that produce this type of striper. EZ liner is the closest to us. This will be big advantage for build inspections, warranty, service & repair parts.
 - a. EZ Liner - Orange City, IA
 - b. MB Companies, Inc – Montgomery, PA
 - c. KellyCreswell – Springfield, OH
2. We have other equipment from EZ Liner and they have provided great service, parts & warranty.
3. Our Public Works Traffic Department have and had equipment from MB Companies and other manufactures. The equipment from EZ Liner is of better quality and has proven to be a better product over time. The EZ Liner Striper meets our needs better than the other manufactures.

 2. Platform – Section 3
 - a. Construction – Bid spec welded Steel diamond plate bed – MB specs metal constructed equipment platform.
 3. Air Supply System – Section 4
 - a. A number of air supply system items not address in MB specs.
 4. Engine System – Section 5
 - a. Engine Make – Bid spec 23 HP Honda GX690 – MB specs 20 HP Kohler
 - b. A number of engine system items not address in MB specs.
 5. Hydraulic System – Section 6
 - a. A number of hydraulic system items not address in MB specs.
 6. Moisture Separator – Section 7
 - a. MB specs does not address this section
 7. Paint Tanks – Section 8
 - a. Inspection port – Bid Sec 4” port – MB specs do not address this item
 8. Airless Paint Supply Pump – Section 9
 - a. Airless Paint Pumps minimum capacity – Bic spec 3.1 GPM – MB specs 2.5 GPM
 - b. A number of airless paint supply pump items not address in MB specs.
 9. Paint Filter – Section 10
 - a. MB specs does not address this section
