**Public Hearing Requirement:** A public hearing is required for this license application. 71 notices were mailed to residents and property owners within 300 feet of the premises. The notice was e-mailed to the Stadium Village Commercial Association and the Mid-City Industrial Neighborhood Association on July 20, 2016. The public hearing will be held on August 15, 2016, at the Community Development & Regulatory Services Committee meeting.

**Background:**

The applicant holds a Place of Entertainment license and will operate this license in conjunction with the Extended Hours license. The applicant proposes to extend the closing hours of operation for their karaoke singing Tuesday through Thursday until Midnight; Friday and Saturday until 3:00 am.

The applicant contacted the Stadium Village Commercial Association, Prospect Park Neighborhood Association, and Council Member Cam Gordon's Office on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 regarding this application.

**Findings as Required by the Minneapolis Licensing Code:**

The Licenses and Consumer Services Division has analyzed the application and concludes that the application has answered the following:

**A security plan that describes the security features, including personnel and equipment, that the applicant will employ and how they will be utilized:**

The applicant will operate their Place of Entertainment license with Extended Hours using the existing security model which includes a 9 camera security system and on site staffing. Personnel will be on site during all hours of operation. The applicant employees will report any incidents to the manager. If needed during any disturbance, staff will utilize a panic button as well as call police.

Inspector Kathy Waite of the 2<sup>th</sup> Police Precinct has reviewed the application and met the applicant's representatives in person to discuss security issues.

**Description of how the applicant will maintain the orderly appearance and operation of the premises with respect to litter and noise:**

As a part of every shift's duties, the karaoke rooms and surrounding 100 foot area outside is kept free of liter and garbage bins are emptied. Four small rooms are used for karaoke and are sound proof. Sound cannot be heard outside of the rooms once the doors are closed. The karaoke machines only have two small speakers to produce the music and singing. To ensure no noise complaints are received, only staff is allowed to control the volume.

**Description of how the business will have people exit the establishment at closing time and during an emergency that requires all people to exit the establishment quickly:**

The on duty manager and staff will ensure the orderly exit of patrons.

**Such other reasonable and pertinent information as the city council may require**

Upon request, the licensee shall meet representatives of the City of Minneapolis to discuss any safety, security or operational concerns.

**Proximity to permitted or conditional residential uses.**

The nearest residentially zoned property is located directly across the street, which is the University of Minnesota McNamara Alumni Center.

**Nature of the business and its impacts of noise, light and traffic.**

Noise will be kept to a minimum by staff ensuring any unruly patron is asked to leave in a timely fashion and no one will be allowed to loiter in the area. Noise from the singing is greatly reduced due to the use of two small speakers for each machine and sound proofing of each room.

**Conformance with applicable zoning regulations, including but not limited to use, yards, gross floor area and specific development standards.**

The business is categorized as a hair salon with an accessory use for Karaoke rooms, which has been a permitted use in the C-1 district.

**History of complaints related to the use.**

No complaints have been reported.

**RECOMMENDATION (pending public hearing):**

Council Member Cam Gordon's office has no objections to this application. No complaints or other issues have been reported.

If approved, the license applicant will be granted to operate within the following Extended Hours:

Tuesday through Thursday until Midnight  
Friday and Saturday until 3:00 am

This is an annually reviewed license. It will be possible to restrict the hours further if there are violations related to the Extended Hours License.
