**Subject:**

Contract with Hennepin County for contraception services to under and uninsured teens through the School Based Clinics.

**Description:**

1. Accepting \$24,000 from Hennepin County to provide contraception to under and uninsured teens through the School Based Clinics.
2. Authorizing an agreement with Hennepin County.
3. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation of funds to the Health Department.

**Background/Analysis:**

Hennepin County is providing funding for the upcoming school year through its Better Together Hennepin program for long-acting reversible contraception for uninsured and underinsured adolescents through the School Based Clinic Program. This is a pilot project that seeks to remove the barrier of cost for teens that could not otherwise afford this form of contraception, and will also support provider training.
