Minnesota Board of Firefighter Training and Education (MBFTE) training reimbursement

**Description:**

1. Accepting MBFTE funding under the Round 9 training reimbursement program in the amount of \$82,400 plus redistribution funding under the Round 8 training reimbursement program in the amount of \$15.91. This training reimbursement award is for MBFTE approved training conducted between July 1, 2016 and June 30, 2017.
2. Passage of Resolution approving appropriation to the Fire Department.

**Background/Analysis:**

On August 30, 2016 the MBFTE notified the Minneapolis Fire Department that the department had been awarded \$82,400 under Round 9 of their training reimbursement program.

Reimbursement must be requested by August 1, 2017.

A portion of this funding will be used as a reimbursement of training expenses for a potential new class of firefighters in 2017 and provide some anticipated relief to the 2017 operating budget. These credits will also be directly related to ongoing training within the fire department.
