# Recommendation:

- Authorizing appropriate City officials to execute contracts consistent with the approved Community Engagement Plan.

- The process follows the City's adopted Core Principles of Community Engagement




# Goals:

- Ensure participation of neighborhood organization leaders, cultural community leaders, City leadership and other stakeholders in the conversations.
- Provide clear and ongoing communications.
- Develop consensus around recommendations for roles and responsibilities of funded neighborhood organizations, and the roles and responsibilities of the City in responding to and working with neighborhood organizations.
- Ensure a smooth transition of Community Participation Program funding after 2020.



# Structure:



- Participate in training and plan community conversations.

# Roles:

## NCR Staff

- Organize Art of Hosting training
- Facilitate communication
- Facilitate planning
- Consolidate data and develop initial findings

## Neighborhoods 2020 Committee

- Participate in Art of Hosting training
- Assist with planning and facilitation of conversations
- Review draft findings and recommendations
- Report findings and recommendations to NCEC

## Neighborhood Organizations


- Participate in Art of Hosting Training

# Early 2017: Community Conversations

- Neighborhood partners extend invitations to:
  - Other neighborhood boards
  - Cultural community leaders
  - City leadership
  - Other stakeholders

Four to six community conversations facilitated by neighborhood organizations, NCEC Commissioners and NCR staff



# April to June 2017: Review Data and Develop Findings



- Form work groups as needed to follow up on data.
- Neighborhoods 2020 Committee presents initial findings to NCEC and reports back to community.
- NCEC adopts initial findings by June 2017.

# July 2017 to March 2018: Develop Recommendations

- NCR and Neighborhoods 2020 Committee work with neighborhood organization partners to develop recommendations.
- Review of recommendations by stakeholders.
- 45-day review and comment period.
- Final development of recommendations by Neighborhoods 2020 Committee and presentation to NCEC, NRP Policy Board and City Council by March 2018.
