Background/Analysis:

Today's consideration of the Nicollet Island-East Bank and West Calhoun NRP Phase II Action Neighborhood Action Plans marks the final NRP plans submitted to the City Council for approval.

Funding for the NRP began in 1991, the final funding installment was received in 2009, and the NCR took over administration of the Program in 2012. All Minneapolis neighborhoods have been involved in the NRP. Thousands of Minneapolis residents have used the NRP planning process to identify and help meet their neighborhood's housing, safety, economic development, recreation, health, education, social service, environment and transportation needs.

As Minneapolis has changed over the past 26 years, so has the NRP. The presentation will briefly highlight the major financial and program elements of the NRP.
