








Characteristics of organizations that can receive funding to engage the community



59. The group **must have a board of directors** elected annually by the membership of the organization. The board must represent a fair cross-section of the community; neighborhood residents must comprise no less than 60% of the organization's board. An elected board must be in place for a minimum of one year prior to the beginning of the contract year to be considered eligible for funding. (10-0-7)



60. The group must have the **ability to properly manage and account for grant funds**. This includes, but is not limited to, being current on all reporting on previous grants. (10-0-5)
