Regulatory Services has coordinated proposed updates to the Schedule of Civil fines for Administrative Offenses. Changes are indicated in the attached draft resolution.

• Increases revenues to achieve revenue budgets already in place

The addition of the Traffic Control violations into this fine schedule is because Regulatory Services is planning a pilot project to shift some parking violations into administrative citations. This is the first step to implementing that project.

The changes to the fine schedule are highlighted in the below table. The table includes a column with a brief description of the need for the change.
