The McKinley NRP Housing Issue Group met on Tuesday, March 8, 2005 and reviewed site plans and housing layouts from Habitat for Humanity and Renewed Dwellings, Inc. that you sent to the committee on February 23, 2005. Representatives from both organizations attended the meeting at their request. The Housing Issue Group voted overwhelmingly to approve the Habitat for Humanity house to be built on that site citing a better housing fit with the surrounding homes on that block, and also the support that the project has from a corporate sponsor, American Express, willing to invest in our community through volunteer time and a large in-kind donation to the project.

Furthermore, the Board of Directors of the McKinley Community strongly supports the Habitat for Humanity project. The Board has expressed its concern that the project be administered swiftly through the McKinley NRP Housing Issue Group and CPED processes so that the project does not meet any unnecessary delays that would prevent building commencing as soon as possible.
