**Subject: ACCEPTANCE OF A \$50,000 WEED & SEED GRANT FROM
PILLSBURY UNITED COMMUNITIES.**

Recommendation

We recommend that the City accept \$50,000 in federal grant funds from Pillsbury United Communities to provide overtime or other police services as deemed necessary to fulfill the Law Enforcement and Community Policing goals of the Richard Green Central Weed and Seed 2002 work plan. We also recommend that the General Appropriation Resolution of 2002 be amended to increase the appropriation in the Federal Grants Special Revenue Fund (0300-400-P300) by \$500,000, and increase the revenue source (0300-400-P300-3210) by \$50,000.

Background/Supporting Information

The Minneapolis Police Department has participated in the Weed & Seed Federal grant program for several years. This grant is to provide overtime or other policing services as deemed necessary to fulfill the Law Enforcement and Community Policing goals of the Richard Green Central Weed and Seed 2002 Work Plan. The Police Department must participate in the Richard Green Central Weed and Seed Steering Committee, or Sub-Committee Meetings. The Department must also consult with the Weed and Seed Director and/or members of the Steering Committee as needed to maintain communication with the community that ensures the forward progress of the Weed and Seed mission. The grant period is from January 01, 2002 through December 31, 2002.
