The Minneapolis Police Department under the current Labor Agreement, which has been approved by the City Council, approved the GXT Treadmill test as a base for measuring cardiovascular fitness levels and at the same time offers programs for improvement to police officers.

### Background/Supporting Information

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests permission to accept a proposal from Cardiovascular Consultants, Ltd. and enter into a multi-year contract. CVC will provide cardiopulmonary testing services for MPD police officers. The contract will commence February 1, 2006 through December 31, 2010. The tests will cost \$150 through 2006 and a fee increase of approximately 5% will be applied annually through the end of the contract in December 2010. the cost of testing has been budgeted.
