### Background/Supporting Information

Dear Council Members:

In March of this year, the State of Minnesota Department of Health announced their intention of awarding grants of up to \$25,000 to local boards of health for provision of temporary lead-safe housing and relocation costs for families displaced by lead hazard reduction in their primary residence. We are requesting that the appropriate officials be authorized to proceed with this application process.
