## **Background/Supporting Information Attached**

**An All Night Special Food License permits an on-sale beverage licensee that would otherwise have to discontinue all business activities at 2:30 AM to remain open to the public for the sale and service of food and non-alcoholic beverages only. The office of Ninth Ward Council Member Schiff has, over the last two months, forwarded several communications from persons residing near the licensee's place of business that relate to significant neighborhood disturbances that can be reasonably related to patrons of the licensee. MCO Chapter 360.70(e)(1) and(2) specifically confers the ability to revoke this license upon the City Council should the result of a license hearing be to do so.**

**The Licenses and Consumer Services Division recommends that the PS&RS take such action as the outcome of the hearing may merit.**
