Purpose: Amendments to the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Off-Sale Liquor.

On Wednesday, November 28, 2007 at 1:00 p.m. or shortly thereafter, the Public Safety and Regulatory Services Committee of the Minneapolis City Council will consider the following amendments to the Code of Ordinances:

1. Amendments to Chapter 362.40 to allow for an exception to the 2000 foot distance requirement for locations that are zoned C3A (Community Activity Center) and one per block face for establishments that sell wine only.

A copy of the C3A map showing the proposed allowed areas is included in this mailing.

2. Amendments to Schedule J to Increase fees for Off-Sale Liquor and Off-Sale Liquor Growler from \$1,000.00 annually to \$1,500.00.

3. Amendments to add prohibited acts for Off-Sale Liquor:
a. Business will not allow any customer to pay for a purchase with more than \$2.50 in change or coins.
b. The business will not sell beer in singles unless the container holds more than 16 oz.
c. The business will not sell wine or distilled spirits in quantities of 100 ml or less.

4. Amendments include incentives to Off-Sale Liquor licensees to provide alcohol awareness training to staff.
