Background/Supporting Information

The City of Minneapolis engaged Bentley Systems Incorporated in August, 2001 to assist the City in the implementation of Computer-Aided Civil Engineering Software and Enterprise, Concurrent Civil Engineering (Engineering 2000).

City Council approved at its July 23, 2004 meeting amending contract number C-17010 to allow for the purchase of software product and maintenance up to \$100,000 per year for the duration of the software's use. BIS is now requesting, based on advice of the City Attorney, authority for authorized City Officials to enter into a new contract instead of amending the contract using the same provisions as the original action requested.

There is no financial impact. Operating funds will pay the annual maintenance. Sufficient budget is available.
