Background/Supporting Information Attached

The Department is requesting to amend the contract with Hennepin County to receive additional funds to provide home visiting services for pregnant and parenting teenagers ages 19 and under who do not qualify for the State TANF home visiting funds, with specific emphasis on members of the Latino community. The department collaborates with the Minnesota Visiting Nurse Agency and Chicanos Latinos Unidos en Servicio (CLUES) to support: healthy birth outcomes; positive parenting practices and parent-child relationship; parent's ability to respond to the health needs of their children; and, self-sufficiency for new mothers and their families.
