Get ready to order a tree to plant on your Minneapolis property this spring. Starting in March, the City of Minneapolis is offering 1,500 six- to eight-foot trees for only \$25 each. In the past five years, the City Trees program has planted 6,000 trees in Minneapolis.

- Trees are available for Minneapolis residents – and new this year, businesses and nonprofits.
- Choose from several varieties and sizes of trees, including a fruit tree.
- First-come, first-served – order early for best selection. Limit one tree per property owner.
- You'll pick up your tree one of three days in May.
