Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute the grant award for \$490,000 from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Office of Justice Programs for digital in-squad video camera systems for patrol vehicles. The Police Department requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2007 to increase the appropriation by \$490,000. The grant award will operate through the Federal Grant Special Revenue Fund, 0600-400-4182, revenue source 3215.
