Acceptance of the bid of Hawkins Inc. for an estimated expenditure of \$ 60,000.00 to furnish and deliver anhydrous ammonia, as follows:

1.	Approximately 120 tons Anhydrous Ammonia	per ton (35,000 lbs)	\$ 419.75
		per ton (25,500 lbs)	\$ 435.50
2.	Approximately 120 tons Aqueous Ammonia	per ton (35,000 lbs)	\$ 162.55
		per ton (25,500 lbs)	\$ 174.35

Price per ton includes Superfund Tax.

Quantities maybe increased up to 100% at bid prices. Prices firm through February 28, 2003.

Terms are net 30 days with delivery 2-3 days after each request. F.O.B.: Destination.
