**Amending Title 4, Chapter 64 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances  
relating to Dogs, Cats, Ferrets, and Rabbits: License Application and Fee.**

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

That Section 64.30 (a) of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

**64.30. License application and fee.** (a) Every person required to obtain a license under this chapter shall make application to Minneapolis Animal Care and Control for a dog or cat license. The license shall expire on January thirty-first of each year, except that any license issued on or after February 1, 2011 shall be valid for one year from the date of issuance. As a condition for the issuance of a dog or cat license, the applicant shall certify that the dog or cat has been vaccinated against rabies in conformance with the requirements of this Code.
