### Supporting Information

The Police Department currently utilizes the Minneapolis Police Chaplain Corps (MPCC) for chaplaincy services. The Police Department issued a request for proposal on June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2007 to obtain proposals for a new three year renewable contract for these services. The RFP closing date was June 27<sup>th</sup>, 2007. The MPCC was the only vendor who submitted a proposal. The MPD believes the MPCC is fully qualified to perform these services and requests authorization from Council to enter into a three year contract with the MPCC. The expected

start date of the new contract is August 1<sup>st</sup>, 2007 for a three year term with an option to renew the contract for an additional three year term.
