### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute the contract agreement to accept \$100,000 in funding over two years for extra security costs during periods of heightened national security. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2006 in the amount of \$100,000. The grant award will operate through the federal grant fund 0300-400-B131, Revenue Source 3210.
