**Amending Title 18, Chapter 478 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances  
relating to the Traffic Code: Vehicle Operation.**

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 478 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances be amended by adding thereto a new Section 478.490 to read as follows:

**478.490. Traffic control fees.** Traffic control agent services, including but not limited to services required for block obstruction, parades, special events, sporting events and conventions, shall require the payment of fees as established in the director's fee schedule pursuant to section 91.70. The fees shall include a minimum fee, an hourly traffic control fee and a separate overtime fee if necessitated and shall be paid to the city treasurer by the contractor, building owner or agent, or any other person requesting the traffic control agent services. The fee may be increased by fifty (50) percent for requests for traffic control agent services made fewer than thirty (30) days prior to the event. All requests for traffic control agent services shall be made on a form or in a format approved by the traffic control unit.
