Amending Title 9, Chapter 173 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Fire and Police Protection: Fire.

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 173.420 II of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

173.420. Code amended. The Minnesota Uniform Fire Code adopted by this article is hereby amended in the following respects:

~~II. Article 4 of the Uniform Fire Code is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference with the exception of Section 4.101, paragraphs 1, 2, 12, 14, 17, 32, 37, 38, 40, 42, and 45; provided that Section 4.103 shall be amended to add the following:~~

~~The fee for each certificate of registration shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per hour, and established rates per type of certificate are set according to the minimum time needed to provide the service. All annual certificates shall expire on the first day of January of each and every year, and shall be renewed annually on or before said date for as long as said conditions exist. Any temporary certificate shall begin and expire according to the dates noted on the certificate. All certificates required to be issued hereunder shall be issued by the chief of the fire department, or his duly designated representative. Failure to pay the fees set forth in this section on or before the due date shall result in a penalty in the amount equal to the regular fees herein provided.~~

Above times include travel time, inspection time, written orders and re-inspection time. Some certificates require conferences with installers.

II. Section 105 of the Minnesota State Fire Code is hereby adopted and incorporated by reference. Section 105 allows for the issuance of applicable permits and the establishment and collection of corresponding permit fees by the local code official. No person shall engage in, direct, operate or conduct any of the activities, actions or proceedings listed below without first having obtained a permit hereunder. All permits issued hereunder shall be issued by the chief of the fire department or his or her designee. The fee for each permit type shall be based on a minimum hourly fee as established below. This established rate is set according to the minimum amount of fire department staff time needed to provide service, including time for travel, inspection, drafting of orders and consultations with permit applicants. Unless otherwise directed by the issuing authority, all permit fees shall be paid prior to the issuance of any permit. All annual permits shall expire on January 1 of each year and must be renewed on or prior to expiration. Temporary permits shall be effective only for the specific dates stated on the permit.

The permit fees shall be as follows:
