### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests approval to accept the donation of a mobile storage facility/trailer worth approximately \$50,000 from the State of Minnesota Dept. of Public Safety – Div. of Homeland Security. The mobile storage facility/trailer is being donated to the MPD Bomb Unit and St. Paul Bomb Units and Minneapolis will hold the title.

### Background/Supporting Information

The Minneapolis Police Department requests permission to accept the donation of a mobile storage facility/trailer worth approximately \$50,000 for use at the Rosemount bomb training location. This mobile storage facility/trailer was purchased with 2004 Homeland Security grant funds by the Minnesota Dept. of Public Safety – Div. of Homeland Security and donated to the Minneapolis and St. Paul Bomb squads. Minneapolis will retain the title to the trailer. This mobile facility/trailer replaces one that has been in use for 35 years.
