PROGRAM (SHIP) MULTI-GRANTEE INTERVENTION GRANT

**Recommendation:**

Council authorization for the proper City officials to:

1. accept \$270 in additional revenue from the Minnesota Department of Health for the prevention of obesity and tobacco use through policy, systems and environmental change interventions in the healthcare setting, for a new total of \$513,270, and extend the termination date to September 30, 2011.
2. increase both the revenue budget in fund/department 01600-8600130 (revenue code 321507) and the 2011 appropriation in fund/department 01600-8600130 by \$270.

**Background/Supporting Information:**

The Department is requesting to accept additional revenue in State Health Improvement Program (SHIP) grant funding from the Minnesota Department of Health for a multi-grantee project in partnership with Hennepin County and the City of Bloomington. Funds are being used to support the implementation of the Institute for Clinical Systems Integration Guidelines for "Prevention and Management of Obesity" and "Primary Prevention of Chronic Disease Risk Factors" by health care providers for adults and children. SHIP funding was to terminate on June 30 and will now be extended through September. This funding compliments the large SHIP grant that the Department has received to conduct policy, systems and environmental change interventions in the community, worksites and schools.
