Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute a reimbursement agreement with the Federal Bureau of Investigation for reimbursement of overtime expenses for officers participating on the Joint Terrorism Task Force. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2005 in the amount of \$80,000.00. The grant award will operate through the federal grant fund, 0300-400-B131, Revenue Source 3210.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to accept up to \$80,000 in additional funds from the Federal Bureau of Investigation, Counterterrorism Division, to reimburse the Police Department for overtime expenses for approximately six officers who participate full-time on the Joint Terrorism Task Force. The number of officers serving on the FBI Task Force may increase or decrease, with advanced FBI approval. The rate of reimbursement will be the current city-paid rate for each respective officer.
