**Subject Request Permission to Accept Grant Funds for Police Bomb Unit**

### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper city officials be authorized to execute a grant contract agreement with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management for \$55,000 to be expended on equipment and training related to hazardous materials. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2003 in the amount of \$55,000. The agreement for reimbursement for service calls up to \$55,000 will operate through the Revenue Fund, 0300-400-C005, Revenue Fund 3210.
