**Subject Permission Enter into an Agreement with Ventura Village for Security Camera Funding**

### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests permission for the proper city officials to enter into a contract agreement to accept a total of \$65,435 from Ventura Village to pay for security cameras along Franklin Avenue, including the camera installation and one year of monitoring. The Police Department requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2007 by the amount of \$65,435. The grant award will operate through the Grants - Other fund 0600-400-B135, Revenue Source 3720.
