**Subject Request Permission to Execute a Joint Powers Agreement –
with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Emergency
Response Commission to Provide Bomb Disposal Services**

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper city officials be authorized to execute a Joint Powers contract agreement with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Emergency Response Commission. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2007 in the amount of \$54,000. The agreement for reimbursement for service calls up to \$54,000 will operate through the Revenue Fund, 0100-400-C005, Revenue Fund 3455.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department wishes to enter into a Joint Powers Agreement with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Emergency Response Commission to provide bomb disposal services to other jurisdictions within the state as needed and to be reimbursed for these services at a rate of \$175 per hour. The contract is for two years.
