Dear Mr. Moncur:

As you know, we have recently received our beer and wine license. We have not sold a single alcoholic beverage, however we have come to the conclusion that it would be a prudent business move to remain open one (1) additional hour daily. In the short time that we have been open, we have had quite a lot of people come in just as we are closing our doors and/or asking us to stay open later so they may dine with us (especially in the summer). Currently, the sun is just going down about the time we are supposed to close, and there are still many people walking around our urban Uptown neighborhood looking for a place to dine. Accordingly, I would like to request that we revise the Agreement that was signed for the granting of the beer and wine to read,

“That the hours of operation shall be limited to 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and to 11 a.m. to 11 p.m. Friday and Saturday; and”

The text above was actually written as part of the CARAG resolution regarding our beer and wine license, so I am quite sure that the neighborhood would not be opposed to this action. If the above action is not appropriate, please advise how to revise and resubmit our business plan for proper consideration.

# AGREEMENT

The Undersigned, the Managing Member of Noodle 1, LLC, a Minnesota limited liability company which has made application for a Class E On-Sale Wine with Strong Beer license to be located at 1221 West Lake Street, Suite 112 Minneapolis, Minnesota, hereby agrees to the following conditions to issuance and retention of said license:

1. That the hours of operation shall be limited to 11 a.m. to 9 p.m. Sunday through Thursday and to 11 a.m. to 10 p.m. Friday and Saturday; and
2. That delivery hours shall be limited to 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays and to 8 am to noon on Saturday; and
3. That the outdoor seating area shall close by 9 p.m., daily; and
4. That the licensee shall establish a policy to the effect that alcoholic beverages shall be served only to those patrons whom have ordered, are consuming or have consumed a meal. The licensee shall train and instruct all employees strictly abide by the policy and shall prominently display a sign at the point of sale, subject to approval by the City of Minneapolis, within the premise that informs patrons of the policy.

The Undersigned expressly acknowledges that this Agreement has been entered into for the express purpose of inducing the Minneapolis City Council to grant approval of said license and that any violation or deviation from the terms of the Agreement constitutes cause for revocation, suspension or denial of renewal of said license and/ or the imposition of administrative penalties.
