**Subject:** Permission to Accept \$87,600 in Homeland Security Grant Funding from the MN Department of Public Safety, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management

### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper city officials be authorized to execute the grant agreement from the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management for \$87,600 in funding to support overtime and equipment for critical city infrastructure protection. The Department also requests an increase to the general appropriation resolution for 2005 in the amount of \$87,600. The grant award will operate through the Grants - Federal Fund, 0300-400-DT09, Revenue Source 3210.
