## ***The Downtown 100 Chronic Offender Cost***



### **2005 Study of 33 Chronic Offenders** Court Study...

**5,068 days in jail**

**773 medical facility visits**

**91% used detox/chemical health facility**

**45% used mental health facility**

**85% used shelter**

**Cost of the Downtown 33 = \$3.7M**
