**Background/Supporting Information Attached**

The department is requesting to accept this grant award from the General Mills Foundation in support of the effort to develop and implement a city-wide plan to prevent youth violence in Minneapolis. In November the Council established a Youth Violence Prevention Steering Committee. The committee is charged with overseeing efforts to significantly reduce youth violence in Minneapolis. A multi-year plan is due to the City Council by May 31, 2007. After development of the report the committee will oversee its implementation.
