Subject Request Approval to Enter into a Contract Agreement for the Financial Crimes Task Force

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute a contract amendment with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety to receive an additional \$76,200 in funding for Minneapolis Police participation in the Minnesota Financial Crimes Task Force for one year. The Police Department requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2007 by the amount of \$76,200. The contract will operate through the state grant fund, 0600-400-C117, Revenue Source 3215.

Background/Supporting Information

The Minnesota Department of Public Safety is providing state grant funds several local agencies to staff the Minnesota Financial Crimes Task Force. These funds will support one MPD investigator to serve on the task force on a full-time basis for approximately one year.
